

LET'S GO OUT TO PLAY! Kitkit: a game from BANGLADESH

This is a kind of hopscotch, but a bit trickier! You need at least two players. Chalk a square on the ground divided into 4 triangles. Find a pebble.

- 1. Throw the pebble into a triangle. It must not touch the line.
- 2. Hop into that space and flick the pebble into the next triangle with your hopping foot.
- 3. Continue to hop round the 4 triangles repeating 'kit-kit' and pushing the pebble as you go.
- 4. When you have got round all the spaces, hop onto the pebble.
- 5. All done. Next player has a go.

Your turn ends if:

- the pebble lands on a line
- you stop repeating "kit-kit-kit"
- you stand on two feet
- you miss the pebble at the end.

The winner is the person who gets the whole way round.

If you all make it, play another round!
